

Appraisal District Deadline Approaches for Business Personal Property Renditions

IMPORTANT: Beginning in 2018, the new business personal property rendition deadline for all businesses will be April 2, 2018. “A rendition is a report that lists all the taxable property you owned or controlled on January 1, 2018 such as inventory and equipment used by the business,” said Jackie Martin, Chief Appraiser of Andrews County Appraisal District. “The exception to this would include exempt property such as church property or an agriculture producer’s equipment used for farming.”

If a rendition is filed late, is incomplete or not filed at all, a 10 percent penalty will be imposed. Property owners may file a written extension request for a 30-day extended deadline to May 1 with Terri Kraft, Business Personal Property Appraiser.
