



Due Date for Business Personal Property Rendition or Extension

IMPORTANT: The Business Personal Property Rendition deadline is **April 15**.

“A rendition is a report that lists all the taxable property you owned or controlled on January 1, such as inventory, supplies, furniture, fixtures, machinery, equipment and vehicles used by the business,” said Susan Brewer, Chief Appraiser of Andrews County Appraisal District. “The exception to this would include exempt property such as church property or an agriculture producer’s equipment used for farming.”

If a rendition is filed late, is incomplete or not filed at all, a 10 percent penalty will be imposed.

Property owners may file a written extension request for a 30-day extended deadline to May 15. This request is due on April 15.
