Business Personal Property Rendition or Extension deadline is April 15 of each year

Andrews County Appraisal District is reminding all business owners that they must report business personal property by filing a rendition. Business personal property is tangible property such as inventory, supplies, furniture, fixtures, machinery, equipment, vehicles, and trailers used to produce income, but it does not include land or buildings. A rendition is a report that lists all the property the business owned or controlled on January 1 of this year. Owners do not have to report exempt property, such as church property with an approved religious exemption or an agriculture producer's equipment used for farming.

If a rendition is not filed, filed late or is incomplete, a 10 percent penalty must be imposed.

Property owners may file a written extension request for a 30-day extended deadline to May 15. This request is due on April 15.
